RESEARCH STUDENTS

Additional to the Application Guidelines, the details of the selection and some special requirements are set by the Embassy of Japan in Thailand as following. Please read carefully before submitting the application.

1. FIELD OF STUDY

Applicants should apply for the field of study they majored in at university or its related field. Moreover, the fields of study must be subjects which applicants will be able to study and research in graduate courses at Japanese universities.

2. QUALIFICATION

- (1) Applicants must have Thai nationality and have been born on or after April 2, 1991.
- (2) Applicants must satisfy any one of the following conditions.
- 2.1 Applicants who are studying or graduated at an undergraduate level and have attained a <u>cumulative</u> **GPA** of at least 3.25 on a 4.00 GPA scale.
- 2.2 Applicants who are studying or graduated at an undergraduate level and have attained a **cumulative GPA of 3.00** on a 4.00 GPA scale and satisfy **any one of the following** conditions.
 - (a) Have passed Level N1 or N2 of the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test (JLPT).
 - (b) Have achieved at least 200 points (excluding 'Writing') in Japanese as a Foreign Language subject of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU).
 - (c) Have achieved an English language proficiency test score that is equivalent to CEFR level B2 or higher (for example: TOEFL iBT 72, IELTS 5.5, TOEIC 785 or higher).
 - (d) Completed or expected to complete undergraduate or graduate program at an institution where the language of instruction is Japanese or English and whose graduates are eligible for admission at a Japanese graduate school.
- 2.3 Applicants who are studying or graduated at a graduate level and have attained a <u>cumulative GPA</u> of at least 3.50 on a 4.00 GPA scale at a graduate level <u>and also</u> have attained a <u>cumulative GPA of at least</u> 3.00 on a 4.00 GPA scale at an undergraduate level.

Note: The date of issue of the certificates of language proficiency should be no earlier than two years from the date of application.

3. APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES IN THAILAND

The Embassy of Japan in Thailand will conduct the First Screening of applicants by means of screening the submitted application documents, written examination and interview. The decision on successful candidates made by the Embassy of Japan is final and the reasons will not be disclosed. Any queries on the final decision will not be entertained.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1. <u>These documents must be written in English or Japanese</u>, or if they are written in any other languages, a translation in either English or Japanese should be attached.
- 2. Applicants are <u>not requested to submit Recommendation Letter and Medical Certificate at the time of application</u> even though they are written in the application guidelines.
- 3. Applicants must paste photographs to the Application Form and Admission Form. However, the photograph data can also be pasted and printed out.
- 4. If applicants are graduate students or graduated at a graduate level, applicants must submit their academic transcripts and certificates of graduation both undergraduate and graduate level, or the certificate of prospective graduation if not yet graduated.
- 5. Applicants will be disqualified if the applicants do not fulfill all the requirements or the submitted application is incomplete.
- 6. The submitted **documents will not be returned**.

- 7. Applicants must choose <u>one</u> of the examination venues (Bangkok, Chiang Mai, Khon Kaen, Songkhla) and circle <u>on the Admission Form</u>.
- 8. Applicants must submit the above application documents **by post** to the Embassy of Japan in Thailand or Consulate–General of Japan in Chiang Mai. The set of applications **must be arrived** at the Embassy or Consulate–General **by Wednesday**, **4 June 2025** (regardless the date of the postal stamp). Hand or messenger delivered documents will not be accepted.
