- (1.3) Applicants must have attained <u>a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00</u> on a 4.00 GPA scale at an undergraduate level.

2. APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES IN THAILAND

The Embassy of Japan in Thailand will conduct the First Screening of applicants by means of examination of submitted application documents, a written examinations and interviews. The reasons for the results of the screening will not be disclosed. Applicants who have passed the First Screening will be recommended to MEXT. MEXT will select the successful applicants of the Second Screening.

Please understand that submitted application documents will be screened. Applicants may be selected to take the written examination in limited numbers.
